➤ **Review of Previous CC Meeting minutes on 2-27-19:**

➤ **Go over the proposed budget, goals, and action plans for the SIP for the 2019-2020 school year:**

Current goals discussed: We have made 92% avg attendance in $\frac{3}{4}$ terms this year, so progressing well. We have been holding our grade level CTT's under the direction of our ELA coordinator, so progressing well. We are progressing in our goal to have 62% of our students in K-3 make typical or better progress in Dibels. We are progressing in our goal to have Sage proficiency in math grow from 35-38%. We have completed our staff LEAN training and are progressing in utilizing the principles to develop curriculum maps and reduce non-essentials in our work. Last year we had \$49,373 in Trustlands and will have 0 carryover.

Goals for 2019-2020 were discussed and agreed upon: 1) Our K-6 cumulative attendance will be at 94% or better in $\frac{3}{4}$ terms minimum. No Trustlands funds will be needed for this goal. 2) At least 65% of our K-3 students will make typical or better progress in Dibels/Acadience Reading fluency. We plan to spend about 50% of the Trustlands to pay for two Instructional Aides and funding for audio enhancement (in conjunction with matching funds from the Davis Education Foundation), digital curriculum, and technology needs to support this goal. 3) Our 3-6th grade students will earn an average of 40% proficiency on the Math Rise testing. We plan to spend about 50% of our Trustlands to pay for two Instructional Aides and funding for audio enhancement (in conjunction with matching funds from the Davis Education Foundation), digital curriculum, and technology needs.
