Technology in the Classroom

Digital technology has entered every realm of our lives, from home to the classroom, and Resurrection College Prep High School teachers are creatively integrating new tools to add depth and richness to the learning of their students.

Apple iPads, interactive white boards and Rosetta Stone language software are several of the tools that are being embraced by students and teachers. "I use my iPad frequently in my classroom," said Religious Studies teacher Joe Lascon. "I use various apps to supplement the content in my curriculum like Glo Bible software, Prezi interactive notes, and timeline apps. I also use polling software, like Socrative, that allows me to get real time data."

Math teacher Jessica Abezetian utilizes the Microsoft OneNote program to create outlines and notes for her classes. By connecting her laptop to the interactive white board in her classroom she can have students come to the white board to demonstate work and then she is able to save

classwork for future reference. "If a student is absent," said Abezetian, "I can e-mail the notes directly to her and she can see what we worked on in class." She also likes to insert files and links that allow students to have additional resources, explanations and on-line tutorials.

Resurrection teachers have commented on their ability to engage students more deeply with the visual and interactive aids that are part of new technologies. An interactive geometric model of a shape that students can manipulate can give students a concrete way to explore geometry. In a World History class, a "virtual field trip" to Versailles on an iPad can help students appreciate the architecture of the historic French palace and understand in greater detail the life of its builder, Louis XIV. During the election season, students in a Social Studies class used an interactive white board to work with an interactive electoral map, tesing various scenarios to determine the possible election results. A Sociology class researched poverty in the United States and then prepared interactive displays in the school library to share their knowledge. The World Language Department utilizes Rosetta Stone software as an interactive learning tool to enhance instruction in the languages currently offered at Resurrection, including French, Italian, Latin and Spanish. Expansion of the Rosetta Stone program will also allow students to study languages not currently offered at Resurrection.

The rapid pace of technology changes and the knowledge and innate ability of current students is a contrast to parents and alumnae who remember learning to type on manual typewriters. Today's students are comfortable with expanding

technology and naturally embrace new tools. Students are accustomed to submitting homework electronically and are more frequently working with classmates online via social networking applications, like Edmodo, an online educational platform. Using Edmodo as an extension of the classroom, teachers are posting homework, tutorial links and test results. Students can ask each other questions online and classmates can post answers, which encourages collaborative learning. Students flourish as they take ownership of the learning tools and take control of their own learning.
