



Task 1 – Listening and Keywords

Create your own questions for “Who Wants to be a Millionaire”. Your questions and answers will be checked by Mr Dottridge and the best ones will be used by the class.

- 9 Questions in total with 4 multiple choice answers for each one
- The questions should be fairly easy at the start and more difficult as they go on
- The questions should all be based on short classical music extracts

Some possible questions might be

- What is the main instrument playing?
- Which family of instruments can you hear?
- What is the time signature?
- What is the tonality?
- Which device is being used?
- What happens to the dynamics in this extract?

You can use any classical music extracts of your choice. If you struggle to find something then search for “50 Masterpieces of Classical Music” on Youtube

For each section, comment on what you hear for timbre (instruments), tonality, rhythm, dynamics, melody and texture

- Section one (with first melodic theme) 0:00-0:54
- Section two (with second melodic theme) 0.55 – 1:31
- Section one for the second time 1:32-2:58
- Middle section 2.59-4:13
- Section one for third time 4:14-4:36
- Section two for the second time 4:37-5:14
- Section one for the fourth time 5:15-6:39
- Section two for the fourth time 6:40-7:12
- Coda 7:12-end

Finish with a general review – what do you think of this music and how does it make you feel?

Task 3 – Composition
