Record yourself reading your answers. You probably have an App on your phone to help you do that. Listen to your answers thinking about how you can improve them.

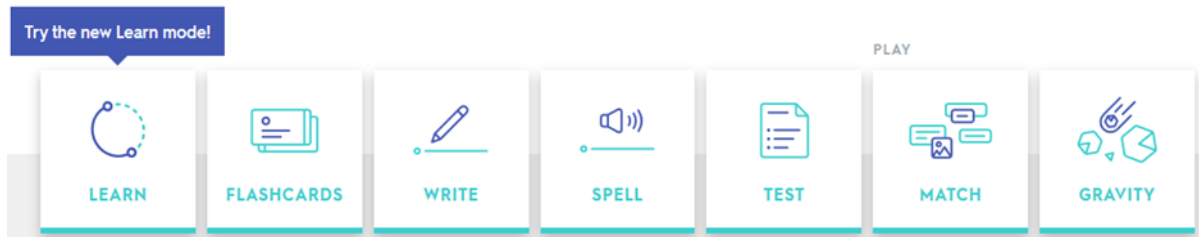
Practice your answers! Read them aloud to a friend.
