The O'Fallon Safety Town program is a safety education program designed exclusively for young children that are between the ages of 4 ½ and 6 ½ years. The safety program began in 1985 and is conducted by the O'Fallon Police Department, with the assistance of professionally trained staff and volunteers. As a Safety Town Counselor, you will have a supervised relationship with the children attending Safety Town. You will be responsible for assisting children with classroom activities, and directing their participation on the Safety Town City layout. You must possess the ability to communicate and interact comfortably with young children, your peers, and the program staff. You will be expected to accept and act on the direction of the program officer(s) and the classroom teacher. Applications can be picked up in the main office and are due by **March 29th**.
