Students interested in taking an accelerated 8th grade math course in the summer of 2019 must notify their school counselor of their intent so that schools can plan accordingly for potential changes in a student's academic schedule. Please complete and return this form to your counselor no later than May 24, 2019.

Process and Required Documentation for Summer Accelerated Math

Students and Parents:

Prior to sign up and acceptance into a summer accelerated math class, you must complete the attached "Notice of Intent to Participate in Math Acceleration Class" document and return it to your middle school counselor no later than **May 24, 2019**.

After completion of accelerated math class:

By August 16, 2019, you must submit documents verifying the completion of work and grade received with appropriate signatures to your counselor in order to receive final approval from the school principal.

- School principals are the sole determiners of the approval of courses to determine student placement
- Families are responsible for the completion of documentation and submission of the required documentation.

Be advised that:

- Completion of a non-NSD recommended summer accelerated math class does not automatically ensure advancement to the next level of course work in NSD. Principal evaluations of coursework are required before advanced placement will occur. **Students who earn only partial credit for an accelerated 8th grade summer math course will not advance to the next level of course work in NSD and must enroll in a full year of 8th grade math in 2019-2020.**
- Enrollment in Algebra I is a year-long commitment for the 2019-20 school year.

Options for Math Acceleration

Option 1: Take the Accelerated 8th Grade Math Summer Course offered by the NSD

Considerations: This course will use the district-adopted 8th grade math curriculum taught by a qualified teacher. This course moves at a fast pace covering a year-long course compressed into 5 weeks and involves many hours of additional homework. Students who earn only partial credit for 8th grade summer math course will not advance to the next level of course work in NSD and must enroll in a full year of 8th Grade Math in 2019-20.

Considerations: Proof of completion of the online math course must be submitted to the school counselor by **August 16, 2019**, or the student will be placed in 8th grade Math for the 2019-20 school year.
