TIPS FOR PREPARING FOR EXAMS

Develop a Study Plan

- Study Guides will be available starting May 3rd in all classes. Check MyHomework.
- Make a Plan: If there are certain subjects that will require more prep, plan accordingly.
- Use Flex Time Wisely: Schedule time, in your planner, to meet with teachers. Find quiet study areas to study to avoid distractions.

Wellness/Review Week May 20-24

At IWA, the week before midterms and finals is considered "wellness/review week" What do we mean by this?

- Only Project Based Exams are due this week.
- No Tests, Quizzes, Projects, Homework, or Papers due this week. This is to alleviate stress and help students stay focused on reviewing material for upcoming exams. This additionally gives you time to complete project based exams.
- Instruction continues in all classes and new material may be covered during class. This is to allow continued learning. Concepts will be assessed on the semester exam.
- Flex time is protected. This means that no extra curricular events or meetings can occur during flex time. Students who need to make up tests/quizzes may continue to take those in the testing room. It is expected that students use flex time wisely to meet with teachers for extra help and prepare for upcoming exams. *The Library, Area outside the library, courtyard, balcony, and Matel Center will be quiet individual study areas.*
- Ms. Thompson will be hosting wellness workshops to help balance stress and time management as you prepare for exams (yoga, coloring, tea, etc.).
- May 23rd: In Class Review Day
 - Teachers will be planning lessons to help you review for upcoming exams.
 - No new content will be covered.

- May 24th: On Campus Review Day
 - This is an optional attendance day for you to study on campus and meet with teachers.
