

## Middle School Supply List Grades 7-8

Students in both grades 7 and 8 will need the following school supplies:

- 1 universal binder This binder holds materials for the core subjects and is carried from class to class and between home and school. For durability and portability, we have found that Velcro or zip-up varieties with carrying handles are best.
  - **Note:** Backpacks are kept in lockers during the school day, and students carry around subject materials and essential supplies in binders.
- 1 home-based organizational system for storing papers/documents (for example, an accordion style expanding file **or** file box with file folders)
- 4 1" 3-ring binders (for Christian studies, science, English, and Latin)
- 4 packages of dividers, 5-subject (for Christian studies, Latin, science, and universal binders)
- 1 composition book, 100 pages, college-ruled (for English)
- 1 spiral notebook, 100-150 sheets, college-ruled (for history)
- 1 NIV study bible Study version recommended. The NIV translation is used in all Christian studies classes.

## **Physical Education**

- Required Physical Education uniform All Middle School students will take Physical Education and must wear a Physical Education uniform during class. Information on how to order your Physical Education uniform is available on the School Uniforms page on our school website (<a href="www.tbcs.org/community/student-life/school-uniforms">www.tbcs.org/community/student-life/school-uniforms</a>). It is very helpful to have a second Physical Education shirt. All students must order their P.E. uniform prior to the summer order deadline even if registered for P.E. during spring semester; please note order deadline posted online. Uniforms will be distributed to students by the Physical Education teachers on the first day of regular class.
- White athletic socks minimum 2 pairs
- Athletic shoes cross-trainers recommended. It is also recommended that a student who has specific shoes for a sport (i.e. volleyball, basketball) bring a pair of athletic shoes specifically for Physical Education as court shoes should not be worn out on the field and then again in the gym.
