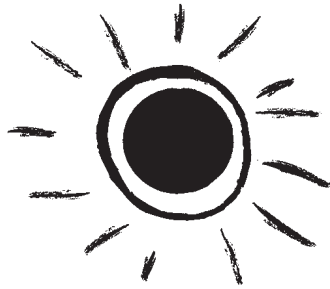

Poetry in the City is a two week workshop in which campers write creative work in response to New York destinations. To get us started each day, campers will be asked to write poems or stories in response to writing prompts that reflect the day's trip. In addition, there will be an opportunity to share creative work before we depart BWL each day. During the second week, we will take a trip to the Ashokan Reservoir and have a workshop with a master poet at the Poetry Barn in West Hurley, NY. In addition, we will take a vertical tour of Saint John the Divine on the Upper West Side of Manhattan, and visit stores full of odd things like The Evolution Nature Store in NoHo. In these environments and others, campers will be encouraged to take notes, write poems, come up with stories or draw pictures for graphic novels. Throughout the two week workshop we will play poetry games each day, which include Metaphor Dice, riddles, broken telephone, Exquisite Corpse, poetry scavenger hunts and more. At the end of the two weeks, each camper will come away with one bound and finished product. If you are looking for a fun and creative way to spend your first two weeks of summer, come to Poetry in the City and prepare to be inspired.
