# Tuition-Based Full Day Kindergarten 2019-2020 School Year



## The cost of the program...

- Fees for the optional full-day kindergarten tuition-based program are \$3,250 for the 2019-2020 school year.
- Financial assistance may be available for those who qualify based upon income.



# Important Information for Full Day Tuition-based Kindergarten

- Kindergarten hours will be as follows:

## Half Day program (no tuition charge)

Half-day AM (M,T,Th,F): 9:15 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.

(Wed): 9:45 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Half-day PM (M,T,Th,F): 12:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

(Wed): 12:45 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

## Full Day program (\$3250 tuition)

Full-day (M,T,Th,F): 9:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

(Wed): 9:45 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

## Classroom Composition

- Current Class Size Guidelines...21-25
- The composition of each kindergarten classroom will be dependent upon enrollment numbers for half and full day students at each building.
- Half and full day students may be in the same class with half day students leaving at lunchtime.

# Important Information for Full Day Tuition-based Kindergarten

- In order to be **guaranteed** a spot in the full day (tuition-based option) program....
  - Registration must be fully completed (including all required documents) no later than February 28, 2019.
  - A \$500 deposit must be on file no later than February 15, 2019. This deposit is refundable until April 3, 2019.

# Important Information for Full Day Tuition-based Kindergarten

- After February 28<sup>th</sup>, a waiting list will be formed at each building, and admission to full-day will be provided dependent upon availability.
- An electronic payment plan is required for those who register for the full-day tuition-based option. Unless prepaid in full, monthly payments of \$275 will be electronically debited beginning August 2019 to May 2020.



# Transportation

- Students who qualifying for transportation will be bussed for both half day and full day options.
- Bus routes are dedicated for KDG students only.



# Hot Lunch



- Full Day students will have the option to bring their lunch or participate in the hot lunch program.
- 2018-2019 school lunch price is \$2.95. Students have an account that can be funded through the Skyward parent portal or webstore. The student's pay for their lunch using this account.
- School policy is not to deny children lunch unless specifically requested by the parent.
- Federal School Lunch Program assistance is available to those who qualify.

# Bridge Programs for Full Day Care

- Private third party company, Ivy League, will provide 6:30-9:15am & 3:00-6:30pm care at each school building.
- Ivy League will also provide care for late start Wednesdays.
- This is available to KDG families.
- Ivy League sets those fees and administers that program.
- Representatives from Ivy League will be at both schools on February 7<sup>th</sup> during registration to answer questions.
