

- Write a note and send it with your child upon their return to school.




WARNING and AT RISK for Chronic Absenteeism

Days Missed Can Add Up.

Kindergarten registration for the 2019-2020 school year begins December 1, 2018 for Groton residents that have a child who will be five years of age on or prior to January 1, 2020. Please call 860-572-2100 or email gellis@groton.k12.ct.us after November 1st to setup your

gellis@groton.k12.ct.us after November 1st to setup your registration appointment. To ensure that your child is placed

in the elementary school where they are districted to attend, or to participate in the magnet lotteries please register your child prior to April 15, 2019.

If your child is already enrolled in one of our Groton Public Schools preschool programs and will be five years of age on or prior to January 1, 2020, it is not necessary to register the student for Kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school year.
