2015-16 SES information - Free Tutoring for eligible students

Supplemental Educational Services (SES) provided at no cost to you!

Federally funded services are being offered to the following elementary schools:

Sacajawea Elementary and Jefferson Elementary

What are Supplemental Educational Services?

Supplemental Educational Services provide academic enrichment in reading, language arts or math outside the school day – that is, before or after school, on weekends, or during breaks at no cost to families. The SES sessions are high quality, research-based, and specifically designed to increase the academic achievement of eligible students.

If sufficient funds are not available to serve all students who are eligible, the Richland School District must give priority to the lowest-achieving eligible students.

Who is eligible?

Students from Sacajawea and Jefferson Elementary Schools who qualify for free or reduced-price lunch are eligible to apply for tutoring for the 2015-16 school year.

How do I apply?

To sign your child up for supplemental education services, you may complete paperwork during one of the open enrollment windows (dates below). An enrollment form is attached and enrollment forms are also available at your school during the open enrollment window dates.

Who provides the tutoring?

Families choose the vendor they want to provide tutoring for their student. A list of local providers is attached. The list is also available on the Richland School District Website. For a statewide SES Providers list as well as more information about each provider please go to:

If transportation to the tutoring site is required, it is the parents' responsibility.

Applications for SES 2015-16 will be accepted:

October 2- October 16, 2015

November 2- November 16, 2015 This window will open only if there is available space after the first window. Tutoring will begin the week of January 25th, 2016 and will be completed by March 18th, 2016.

If you choose free tutoring for your child please remember that participation is required. If your child does not attend the assigned tutoring sessions, you will give up his/her eligibility and tutoring services will be offered to another interested family.
