

GUIDELINES FOR THE POCHE' PROUET ASSOCIATES, LLC SCHOLARSHIP

- I. In order for a student to be eligible to apply for this Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

The Applicant:

- A) must be a U.S. citizen;
- B) must be a Louisiana resident and a graduate of an accredited Louisiana high school;
- C) must be an incoming first time freshman;
- D) must be enrolled as a full-time student majoring in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering or Architecture at The University of Louisiana at Lafayette;

II. Disbursement of Scholarship Funds

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette and Poche' Prouet Associates, LLC will handle the disbursement of the scholarship checks. After verification of registration, the recipient will receive \$500 at the beginning of the Fall semester.

The second \$500 will be provided at the beginning of the subsequent Spring semester. The subsequent scholarship will require the recipient to post a minimum of a 2.5 G.P.A., be in good standing with the University, and be enrolled in mechanical or electrical engineering or architecture during the Fall and Spring semester of the scholarship year in order to validate the Spring portion of the scholarship payment.
