MVCC Proposed Bylaw Amendments – April 10, 2019

(1) Purpose and Intent – These Bylaws shall be the operating guidelines of the Mountain View Elementary School Community Council (“MVCC”). The intent of these Bylaws is to comply with the statutes enacted by the Utah State Legislature, currently contained in Utah Code Ann. §§~~53F-2-404~~, 53G-7-1202, 53G-7-1203, 53G-7-1204, 53G-7-1206, ~~53F-2-404~~ 53G-7-1305, and administrative rule.

(5) Meetings – All MVCC meetings will comply with the notice requirements of Utah Code Ann. § 53G-7-1203. The first meeting of a new school year will be set at the last meeting of the prior school year. The remaining regular meetings of a school year will be set at the first meeting of the school year. Additional meetings may be scheduled as needed throughout the year provided that appropriate notice is given to the public.

At each MVCC meeting, the principal or their designee shall provide an updated accounting of the current year’s funding status for the school, including the balance of expenditures, what monies remain encumbered, and any remaining unspent funds.

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[Notes to proposed amendments: The proposed amendments to Section (1) place the order of the statutes in sequential order and add a new Utah Code section due to the creation of the Teacher and Student Success Program, which replaces the traditional School Improvement Plan while still requiring community council input on the new Program. The proposed amendment to Section (5) adds a requirement for a current LAND Trust funds accounting to be presented by the school administration at each council meeting.]
