ALA ILLNESS POLICY

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We appreciate your partnership in helping ALA maintain a healthy school environment. We ask you to please keep your child home if they have any of the following symptoms:

- **Fever/Temperature:** Your child has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher. They may return to school **AFTER** being fever-free for at least 24 hours **without** the use of fever reducing medication such as Tylenol or Motrin.
- **Vomiting and/or Diarrhea:** Please keep your child home until they are symptom free for at least 24 hours. Your child must be able to consume his/her regular diet without any problems.
- **Pink eye:** Your child may return to school **AFTER** a full 24 hours of antibiotic or a doctor's note.
- **Strep-throat:** Your child may return to school **AFTER** a full 24 hours of antibiotic treatment and fever-free.
- **Chicken Pox:** Please keep your child home until all blisters have formed scabs. Typically, children miss 5-6 days of school for the disease to run its course. Please notify the front office if your child has been diagnosed with Chicken Pox.
- **Lice:** Students with lice should NOT attend school until they have been treated. Before returning to class, the student along with the parent must do a lice check with the Health Aide.
