Re: Diabetic Care Plan

Upon reviewing the student health record, it has been determined by the school nurse that your child has diabetes. To better take care of your child and make sure that they are healthy and safe while at school, we will need a **Diabetic Care Plan**. This can be filled out by a parent/guardian or doctor. We will still need a "Consent for Medications" form filled out by the parent and physician for insulin and emergency medications. (Exception is when a student has a pump)

A Diabetic Care Plan is an individualized management plan that will allow school personnel to recognize and handle high or low blood sugars or a life-threatening emergency while at school.

Please provide your child's school with a diabetic plan along with any other medications such as glucagon. If you do not have a plan, one has been included for you to fill out and sign. **We must have a physician order and parental consent to administer any medications.** If you would like to have your physician fax it to the school, please call the school for fax information. If you should have any questions, please call the school.
