### **Job Summary:**

This will be a full-time, 12-month faculty position as Assistant, Associate or full Professor. Teaching will include courses within Biopharmaceutics, Pharmacy Calculations, and Problem-Based Learning within the School of Pharmacy in Wingate, North Carolina. Additional responsibilities will include those associated with a security track faculty position.

### **Qualifications:**

- PhD with pharmacy background or appropriate advanced degree and postdoctoral experience.
- Pharmacy degree high preferred.
- Previous teaching experience required.
