## Attendance Zone Review Committee

### February – April, 2018

#### Purpose

Review attendance zones in order to address Mansfield’s continued growth and accommodate the district’s newest campuses.

#### Responsibilities of the Committee

The committee will provide feedback in addressing the attendance zones for the new Brenda Norwood Elementary, Almas Martinez Intermediate, and Charlene McKinzey Middle schools, which are scheduled to open in the fall of 2020.

The committee will also review rezoning that will provide relief to overcrowded schools: Lake Ridge High School, Danny Jones Middle School, and Mary Lillard Intermediate School.

This committee is an Ad hoc committee and will be led by David Wright, Assistant Superintendent of Student Services and Support, and Dr. Paul Cash, Executive Director of Facilities and Operations. The committee is advisory only.
