## UIL Eligibility & Advanced Coursework

### September 25, 2018

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this committee is to review the current UIL eligibility requirements associated with advanced coursework in Mansfield ISD and make recommendations to be considered for recommendation to the Board of Trustees by Executive Council and Superintendent concerning any potential changes.
