Overview:

We will be travelling by bus from Cincinnati to Montgomery, Alabama for a day of visiting some of the iconic Civil Rights sites. After spending the night in Montgomery we will make our way to New Orleans. Once there we will spend our time immersed in NOLA's distinct culture and enjoying some of the best food found in the states. We will also spend two of our days serving the community.

Course Goals:

- Students will gain an appreciation for a region of the United States that is significantly different in dialect, culture, food and architecture than anywhere else in the States.

Reading Component: Zeitoun by Dave Eggers

Writing Component: Students will journal in response to their reading and their experiences.

Description:

We will travel by bus from Cincinnati to Montgomery, Alabama to visit some of the iconic civil rights museums. After spending the night in Montgomery we'll head to New Orleans where we'll visit sites like the French Quarter, Warehouse Arts District, Garden District, Jackson Square, St. Louis Cathedral, Lafitte Village, a historic plantation. We will also take a swamp tour in an airboat, participate in a Ghost Tour at night, and spend two days serving the community.

Sample of daily plan

8:00 am wake up/ breakfast in the hotel
9:00 -12:00 tour sites
12:00-2:00 pm lunch and exploring on own
2:00 pm – 5:00 pm tour sites
5:00 return to hotel to freshen up for dinner
6:00-7:30 pm dinner
7:30 – either return to hotel or a scheduled activity like a jazz concert
11:00 – room check

This course is well suited to:

Students who enjoy learning about history, culture and their country and enjoy eating good food.
