Each student should make sure their attire meets dress code BEFORE the night of prom. It is the responsibility of CGHS students to inform their guests of the guidelines.

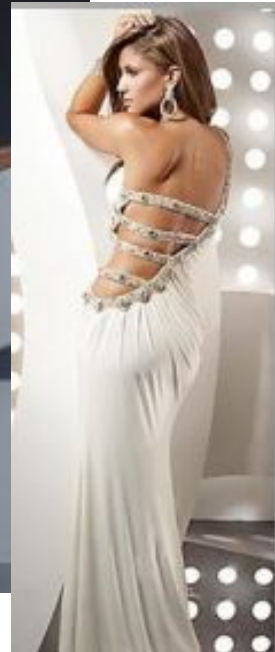
# Guideline #1

Dresses may not have cutouts, nor may the bare midriff be showing. Covering cut-outs, midriffs, and low necklines with sheer netting is not appropriate. (Netting or material should not be see through.) If a two-piece is chosen, material or netting must be used to secure the two-pieces together at all times. **Snaps and hooks will not be permitted.**

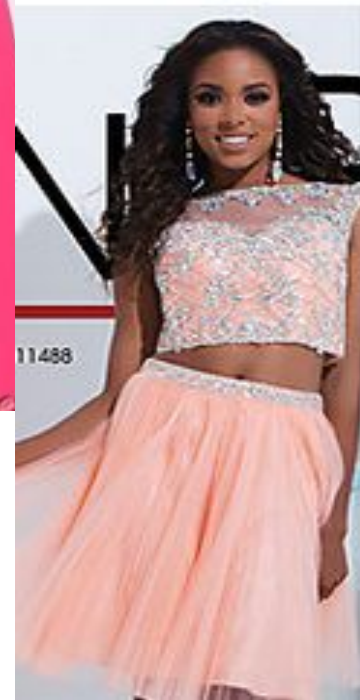
