ECC/Junior School Counselor

### **Responsibilities Include:**

- Develop and implement the four domains of counseling services as outlined in the International School Counselor's Model (American School Counselor's Association), in consultation with the Head of School, Junior School Principal, the Head of Student Support Services, and the Secondary School counselors.
- Provide response services for students/families in crisis situations and act as advisor for administration as requested
- Provide structured in-class guidance lessons as part of the overall pastoral care program for students Grades P1 – 4.
- Consult with teachers, parents and staff to enhance their effectiveness in helping students
- Attend all SSST meetings
- Serve as a member of the ISH Child Safeguarding Team
- Evaluate the Junior School counseling program using data-driven methods
- Refer children and their parents to special programs, specialists, and outside agencies
- Consult with other international schools/AGIS schools to stay current in standards of practice for school counselors
- Observe all ISH standards, protocols and policies
- Engage in on-going professional development and training relating to international school counseling.

### **Qualifications:**

Applicants must have a Master's level degree in school counseling or a related field, as well as experience in the delivery of counseling services within a school setting for both students and families. Experience and training in Positive Discipline, the International School Counseling Model, as well as social skills training is advantageous. Knowledge of psychological testing and the German language is also beneficial.
