## Western Civilizations History Teacher



### Overview

Cardigan Mountain School is a junior boarding and day school for boys in grades six through nine, located in Canaan, New Hampshire. The School seeks to employ individuals who will share our commitment to supporting the School's mission: "To offer a close-knit community that prepares middle school boys—in mind, body, and spirit—for responsible and meaningful lives in a global society." ### The Position

Cardigan Mountain School seeks an experienced and committed educator to teach Origins of Western Civilization in the history department for the 2019-2020 school year. The teaching position is a full-time, 10-month position at Cardigan Mountain School, a boarding school for middle school boys in grades 6-9. The ideal candidate will bring a history of collaborative, self-directed work as well as experience teaching and developing a clearer understanding of our society's historical inheritance.

### Specific Responsibilities

The History Teacher will:

- Teach 2 or 3 classes of ninth grade Origins of Western Civilization classes
- Increase students' skillset and understanding of Western Civilization with a focus on Egypt, Greece, and Rome.
- Differentiate classroom instruction based on student readiness
- Teach in our Global Community Initiative program
- Coach two athletic seasons or perform comparable non-athletic responsibilities
- Participate in our clubs program
- Serve as an advisor to students
- Supervise a dormitory floor

### Qualifications

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree required; Master's degree preferred
- Previous teaching experience in a middle school environment preferred but not required
- Demonstrated proficiency in subject area through previous coursework and/or experience
- Interest in and demonstrated skill in working with adolescent boys
- A shared commitment to an inclusive community, and respect for differences
- Ability to make contributions to School life across multiple facets of our program
