Tuition Fees

The Milford Board of Education (Board) will permit students from other school districts to attend Milford Public Schools at the discretion of the Superintendent. The students or their sending district shall pay a tuition fee to be established annually. The tuition fee may be adjusted as changes in costs indicate unless a multiple year agreement to provide educational facilities is entered into with another Board of Education.
