

## Spring Final Exam Exemptions 2019 for Grades 9, 10, and 11

*An EXEMPTION of a final exam is an earned privilege for those students who have successfully met the exemption criteria. EXEMPTIONS may be forfeited up to the day of the final exam if Academic, Attendance, and /or Conduct criteria no longer meet the criteria for exemptions.*

<b>Academic Requirements</b>	<p><b>Must meet the following criteria for the current semester as of May 10<sup>th</sup>:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Pre-AP/AP/IB Courses:</b> Minimum average grade of <b>85</b></li> <li>• <b>Other Courses:</b> Minimum average grade of <b>90</b></li> <li>• <b>Guthrie/Virtual Courses:</b> No exemptions available</li> </ul>	<b>Submit Final Exemption Forms to US Office</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>May 13<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup></b></p>
<b>Attendance Requirements</b>	<p><b>Must be in <u>GOOD STANDING</u> since January 14<sup>th</sup> with:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No more than three excused absences in the exempted class</li> <li>• No more than 5 tardies in the exempted class</li> <li>• No unexcused absences in the exempted class</li> <li>• Written notice must be given to the Attendance Office within two days , if the absence is to be excused per SBISD Code of Conduct</li> <li>• If required, all ALA logs must be submitted by May 16<sup>th</sup></li> </ul>	<b>Final Exemption Forms Due Date:</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Forms will NOT be accepted after: May 16<sup>th</sup> at 2:30 pm</b></p>
<b>Code of Conduct Requirements</b>	<p><b>Must be in <u>GOOD STANDING</u> since January 14<sup>th</sup> with:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No In-School or Out-Of-School Suspensions</li> <li>• No placement into DAEP</li> <li>• No outstanding items in the Library</li> </ul>	<b>9<sup>th</sup> Grade May Exempt:</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>1 Final Exam</b></p> <p><b>Note:</b> Cannot exempt the same exam in the spring as exempted in the fall</p>
