**Our Students**

A diverse student body is an educational asset to all students. Chadwick students come from 46 different zip codes around the greater Los Angeles area, stretching from Long Beach, to the Marina, to Eastern Los Angeles and to the Pacific Ocean, including the Beach Cities.

**Financial Aid**

In 2018-19, Chadwick will award \$4.2 million in need-based financial aid to 18% of our students. Grants from the Malone Family Foundation of \$2 million in 2003 for need-based scholarships were followed by an additional gift of \$1 million in 2008 from the MacFarlane family, to establish the MacFarlane Leadership Scholarship Fund. The MacFarlane gift was bolstered by additional commitments of \$3 million toward the scholarships and will add to the financial aid funds and resources already committed by the school.

**Outdoor Education**

Chadwick’s Outdoor Education program is one of only nine secondary school programs to be certified by the Association of Experiential Education. The focus of the Outdoor Education program is on encouraging personal development of the students by placing them in new and challenging outdoor situations. Chadwick students therefore participate in one wilderness course per year, culminating in a three -week senior year trip, which includes a three-day solo experience.

**Community Service**

Chadwick’s community service program is predicated on our commitment to the development of individuals of exemplary character. Recognized as one of the outstanding student community service programs in America by *U.S. News and World Report*, our program provides students the opportunity to serve at one of thirteen off campus sites during the school day. Although there are no requirements for service at Chadwick, over 75% of the Upper School chooses to add this weekly commitment as an elective, and 90% of our student body voluntarily participates in some part of the program each year. Our fundamental assumption is that service leads to empathy, empathy to understanding, and understanding to a shared responsibility for a better world.

**Round Square Program**

In October 2008, Chadwick School was elected to membership in Round Square, joining more than 200 other schools from 50 countries on five continents. Round Square schools all share a commitment to the “six pillars” of Round Square: Internationalism, Democracy, Environment, Adventure, Leadership and Service, commonly referred to as the IDEALS. Our membership in Round Square is central to our commitment to developing global citizens. Through this organization students participate in exchanges and engage in international service projects with students from other member schools from around the world. Other U.S. schools include Athenian (CA), Deerfield (MA), and Hotchkiss (CT).

Chadwick International is a Pre-K-12 international school, founded in 2010. Fully equipped with an exceptional 500,000 square feet of state of the art facility the school is located in the Songdo International Business District in Incheon, South Korea. The curriculum at Chadwick International is designed to meet the educational standards of the International Baccalaureate (IB) as well as the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).



## CURRICULUM

### Graduation Requirements

Chadwick students are required to complete four years of English, three years of history and science (two years of which must be a lab science), through Algebra 2 in math, through level 3 in a global language, and one and a half years of visual and/or performing arts. They must also participate each year in physical education or an athletic team and outdoor education. The program requirements meet or exceed entrance requirements for both the University of California and California State University systems.

### Advanced Placement and Highest Level Courses

Students must receive departmental approval to take an Advanced or AP course in mathematics and languages. Other AP courses are open to any student wishing to pursue work at that level. Instructors and faculty advisors work carefully with students in balancing their coursework commitments and in providing counsel about constructing programs. Students wishing to pursue more than three AP or equivalent level courses in one year must submit a petition for permission to do so. It will be reviewed by the advisor, dean of students, instructor(s) and college counselors.

While Advanced Placement is the common top level course in many disciplines, we have also identified the highest level courses that are not available through our AP offerings. These include courses in: Economics, MSON (Malone Schools Online Network) courses and STEM, including Data Structures and Software Engineering.

### Malone Schools Online Network (MSON)

Of the roughly 2,500 private schools in the United States, Chadwick became one of only 38 independent schools to receive a Malone Family Foundation Grant in 2003. Schools are selected for the grants through a rigorous research process, resulting in the addition of an average of three top-level high schools to the Malone network each spring.

Heads of a number of Malone Foundation Schools, including Chadwick, formed a collaborative network under the guidance of Stanford University Online High School to share small classes for our strongest students via telepresence. Through the Malone Schools Online Network, students at participating schools may take advanced classes at other network schools for credit at their own school. **Most of these classes are beyond the AP level.** They are designated as MSON on our transcripts.

### Honors Courses

Chadwick School offers honors courses in the following subjects: Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Spanish, Chinese, French, and Physics/Chemistry/Biology (PCB) at levels 2 and 3.

### Reporting Disciplinary Actions

Disciplinary action is defined as probation, suspension, or expulsion. If a college or university asks a question regarding disciplinary action, Chadwick is obligated to respond to the question, and we strongly recommend that the student respond as well.

### GPA CALCULATION and GRADING

All AP, Post-AP, Advanced, & Honors courses, and courses requiring an AP class as a prerequisite are awarded a full extra point (4.0 scale) in determining weighted GPA.

Chadwick operates on a semester calendar with an A-F traditional grading system.

Chadwick does not compute rank or name a valedictorian. GPAs are calculated on a weighted 4 -point system, based on all Chadwick courses reported on the transcript.

Chadwick School students, like many around the country, are increasingly taking both SAT and ACT tests, ultimately choosing to lean in one direction or the other for second round testing. It becomes more difficult to make “apples to apples” comparisons of average SAT or ACT scores from year to year since fewer reflect the multiple testing results that had been seen in earlier years. Also, worth noting is Chadwick’s Class of 2018 was an unusually small class for us, at 63 graduates compared to typical classes of 90+ students.
