Gull Lake Middle School is a public school accepting any student who is a resident of our school district. We also accept school of choice students from within Kalamazoo County (105) and contiguous counties (105c).

School improvement work is focused on increasing the quantity and quality of opportunities for students to read, write, and speak with purpose across the curriculum through integration of Teach Like a Champion engagement strategies, Disciplinary Literacy, Marzano's Academic Vocabulary, and other literacy-based strategies.
