TCAP/TN Ready Testing

Starting April 16th until May 1st, all CGIS students will be taking the TCAP/TN Ready Standardized Tests for this school year. This will affect doctor appointments and any other appointments your student may have. During testing time periods, we are not allowed to call into the rooms to get your students. All testing should be completed by 11:00 am each day.

At Maryville City Schools, we recommend that each person: Consider how much information you're posting about yourself. Think about who will be able to access this information. It's always better to under share than overshare when you're posting online. A positive self-image and identity start with the choices you make.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL RISING 7th GRADE STUDENTS AND FAMILIES

All students entering 7th Grade are required to have the following immunizations PRIOR to Tuesday, August 6, 2019.

- Tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis booster (T-dap)
- Verification of immunity to Varicella (chicken pox): 2 doses or history of disease with documentation.

In order for your student to start school at CGIS on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 6</u>, <u>2019</u>, an updated immunization record printed on the NEW OFFICIAL "Tennessee Department of Health Certificate" of immunization form must be provided to the school.

***Please use these next few months to get your student's shots updated and printed on the paper form. ***If there is a religious exception for your student's immunizations, please stop by our school clinic to sign a "Religious Exemption" form.
