

2019 Sand Volleyball Managers Meeting Document

- Managers must read rules and policies and are responsible for their team knowing rules and policies
- Managers are responsible for turning in completed roster form and all fees
- Games will start the week of May 6
- Game schedules will be posted at the end of April
- When schedules are released, verify that your team information is correct, if not, contact our office
- Fees have not changed in 10+ years, stayed the same this year
- If you or anyone you know are interested in officiating please contact me
- Managers must submit fully completed roster, paid all fees and verified that they have read the online manager meeting before playing first game
- NO LONGER A WEATHER HOTLINE. SHARE WITH TEAMMATES
- Weather updates will be sent out via email, remind system, Facebook and mankatocer.com
- All games will be rescheduled if time in the season allows
- No glass allowed anywhere at facilities
- No alcohol or tobacco use during games
- Playoff schedule will be released when regular season is concluded
- Scores will be posted on the Caswell website
- Numbers are not needed on shirts, matching shirts NOT mandatory
- One timeout per team per set
- Managers must arrive 10 minutes before game time to fill out scoresheet
- Before signing the scoresheet at the end of the match, VERIFY that your score is correct
- 50 minute time limit on games. 3 games, rally scoring games to 25.
- The two bottom divisions are allowed free substitution into the serving position. Higher levels will substitute per mshsl rules.
- Only legal players may be in the sand. All subs and spectators must stay in grass area
- Write or use labels with first and last names of your players on the scoresheet.
- Comment box on our website for questions, suggestions or concerns
- CoRec players can play either Wednesday OR Thursday nights, not both.
- Include ALL player information on roster including email and phone. We want to be able to survey ALL participants
- Never use profanity, don't argue with officials or your opponent. This is recreational volleyball, not the Olympics.
