Under Approval of the Agenda, Board Vice-Chairwoman Jeannette Nichols made a motion to approve the agenda. Board Member Bruce Shell seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Approval of the Agenda

Superintendent of Operations Eddie Anderson reviewed the Guiding Principles and Middle and High School Redistricting Timelines. Version 2 of the high school and middle school proposals were shared with the Board.

Redistricting

Summary of the high school proposal:

- Study areas 306, 307 and 308 will remain at Ashley High School. The dividing line is Now Mohican Trail for the study areas between Ashley and Hoggard high schools.
- Study areas 218 will remain at New Hanover High School. The dividing line is now Shipyard Blvd for the study areas between Ashley and New Hanover high schools.
- Hoggard High School satellite will be expanded.
- 690 students will be moved that equals 8.93%.

Summary of the middle school proposal:


- Study areas 73, 73A, 73B, 80A, and 80B will remain at Noble Middle School.
- Minor shifts between Noble, Williston and Roland-Grise middle schools attempt to reduce membership at Noble Middle School.
- Generate a satellite for Noble Middle School.
- Expand the Myrtle Grove Middle School satellite.
- 621 students will be moved that equals 11.52%.


