1. Representatives from Campus: Principal, Assistant Principal.
2. Travis outlined bond program and anticipated project scope. Refurbish, renovate, and replace particular items.
3. New classroom wing addition to campus.
4. New classroom and teacher furniture (by separate project).
5. Turf athletic field (by PBK within project).
6. Athletic improvement budget (set aside for improvements now or in future).
7. Design parameter for considerations: Detention, Educational Curriculum.
8. Campus notes strengths and areas of improvement for the building:
 - Gym ceiling tiles desired to be removed.
 - Commons and theater connection works very well for the campus.
 - Front of building is awkward. Front gates are not inviting. No “front entry”.
 - Dismissal process is hampered by approximately 2000 students having to exit through 4 doors.
 - 20 floating teachers is a major stress to the educational curriculum.
 - Over population is a master schedule disruption.
 - Need 2 more science labs.
 - Access from the gyms to the restrooms during games is awkward (PBK to gain more information).
 - Access to the fields from the gyms is problematic as students have to pass by dumpsters.
 - Grade level separation per each floor level works well.
 - Library on the 3rd floor functions well.
 - Campus is in need of a LGI space.
 - Cameras inside the building are poorly functioning and need upgrading.
 - Insufficient outside cameras for site security.

Next meeting to be set up with same group and potentially additional individuals. Meeting initially discussed to be held at either 2pm or 3:30pm sometime the week of 12/10-14.




