ACT update (Justin Whittaker)

- Average 22.5 (good chance that is the highest score in the district)
- Growth from practice test in November increase is 1.5—unheard of growth!!
- \$\$ spent for practice was well spent
- Summit platform also helped with practice and ease with testing

Graduation Plan (Principal Swanson)

- Discussed the possibility of graduation being moved to the Football field (back up auditorium)
- Survey out to the parents/students with pros/cons

 - Reviewed spending
