Applicants should have a Master's degree in Vocal Music or related field from a regionally accredited institution. Teaching responsibilities for the fall semester include applied voice for vocal music majors as well as vocal music minors and non-music majors. Other responsibilities may be assigned depending on candidate's interests and backgrounds.
