

Davis High School Community Council Minutes
March 27, 2019
6:30 a.m.

Attendees: Greg Wilkey, Bradley Chapple, Corrine Barney, Robyn Lawson, Shanna Barker, Kate Niederhauser, Julie Taylor, Janell Tidwell, Gregg Laub, Lance Thaxton, and Ian Johnson.

Council Chair Shanna Barker welcomed the Council and reviewed the minutes from last meeting. Gregg Laub motioned for approval. Kate Niederhauser seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

The student officer Ian Johnson reported that elections and a lot of other activities are going on. All are going well. The civil rights assembly was outstanding.

Kate Niederhauser reported that the PTA is wrapping up activities, and is in need of board members.

Principal Wilkey discussed the community council election process. Elections will begin around the end of April. He also gave an update of the accreditation results. The surveys were generally positive. Five areas with the lowest survey results are being addressed. One area is community partnership and engagement.

Principal Wilkey shared with the Council that pursuant to the Teacher and Students Success Act (TSSA), the school will receive TSSA funds in addition to the Trust Lands Funds next year. It is anticipated that Davis High will receive approximately \$100 per student. There are restrictions on use of TSSA funds similar to Trust Lands funds. As this is new legislation, more guidance will be forthcoming. Nevertheless, the Council will be able to provide inputs on expenditure of TSSA funds.

The Council discussed next year's proposed budget to include some amended requests. Lance Thaxton motioned to approve next year's budget. Gregg Laub seconded the motion. All Council members present voted to approve the proposed budget. Next year's budget was approved.

Shanna Barker informed the Council that there is an upcoming meeting to finalize the Trust Land budget. Based on the outcome of that meeting, the Council may need to meet again on 1 May 2019. However, if there is no need to meet after the Trust Land meeting, the Council will not meet again for this school year. Gregg Laub motioned that the meeting be adjourned. Lance Thaxton seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned.
