## Rationale:

The purpose of the summer reading assignment is to get a jumpstart thinking about US history for the coming year. It will also give you a taste of what the reading assignments will be like in the AP class, though we will typically break a chapter up into smaller sections at one time for reading. Give Me Liberty! Chapter 1 Focus Questions

- 1. What were the major patterns of American Indian life in North America before Europeans arrived?
- 2. To what extent did American Indian and European ideas of freedom differ on the eve of contact?
- 3. Identify the causes that impelled European explorers to look west across the ocean. Which of these were the most important and why?
- 4. Identify the major consequences of European contact with American Indians. Which of these were the most significant and why?
- 5. What were the chief features of the Spanish empire in America?

6. What were the chief features of the French and Dutch empires in North America.
