Dear Loomis Chaffee Parents,

This letter is of interest to parents whose sons or daughters may attend Senior Prom on Thursday, May 23, at The Riverview in Simsbury. Our schedule includes a photo session (parents invited) from 6:15 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Grubbs Quadrangle, the ride to the prom at 7:15 p.m. (all students must ride both ways with us), and a return to campus for a breakfast by 12:15 a.m. At about 1:00 a.m. boarders will return to their dorms and day students will meet their rides. After the students leave campus for their prom, there will be a 7:15 p.m. reception for parents at the Head of School's home.

Day parents must plan to pick up their children at 1:00 a.m. as we do not want students driving at that hour. We recognize that this is a significant request to make of parents, but it is in support of students enjoying what is potentially one of the memorable passages of youth without the dangers that often follow a prom ending early. We do not allow on-campus sleepovers for day students after the prom.

There are classes for underclass students the next day, with a delayed opening. Students must attend all of their classes on Friday, May 24; *absences will not be excused*. Parents and students should consider this before committing to attend the prom.
