

2019 SUMMER SCHOOL CONTRACT

Summer School for Parkland High School, Orefield Middle School and Springhouse Middle School will take place beginning Monday, July 1, 2019 in the Parkland High School Library. Classes will run Monday through Thursday until August 8, 2019. There will be **NO** summer school on Thursday, July 4, 2019 for the Independence Day Holiday. Classes will resume Monday, July 8, 2019.

Students can take a maximum of 2 classes for summer school. There is a great deal of work that is required for the **Summer School program**. **All students must do the testing while at the school, however students are highly encouraged to do work at home to be able to complete the course.**

The cost of each class is \$260.00 payable in cash or check. Any returned checks will be charged an additional fee of \$25 for Non-Sufficient Funds.

Any registrations after NOON on June 26, 2019 will result in a \$25 late fee, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Once payment has been made, there will be NO refunds of any kind made for any reason.

Students are highly encouraged to work on their cyber school classes outside of the regular class period. If internet/computer access is not available from your home, students can work in the library utilizing the Chromebooks around the perimeter of the room from 8:00 am until noon daily. Weekly reports will be e-mailed to you regarding your child's progress. Pre-tests are used to assess each student's knowledge base for that unit and sections may be excused based on the pre-test score. By working longer each day and by completing assignments at home, students have the ability to finish the course early. All assigned work must be completed for a grade for summer school.

Attendance will be taken every day and each student is required to **ATTEND DAILY** and submit his/her assigned daily module (lesson) every day. **ANY STUDENT NOT ATTENDING FOR ANY LENGTH OF TIME MUST BRING IN A NOTE PRIOR TO THE ABSENCE.** All students are still required to complete all of summer school by noon, Thursday August 8, 2019. All work needs to be completed by the last day of summer school. No exceptions will be made. Any discipline referral while in summer school may result in the student's termination from summer school without credit and without refund of monies paid.
