# **1.1** Program Summary

# 1.2 Program Highlights/Key Milestones

## February 12<sup>th</sup> Approved Board of Education Items

• February 12, 2019, the Board approved, a contract award to Elite Modular Leasing & Sales, Inc., for the delivery, installation, lease, dismantle, and removal, and required related services, of a portable modular building to be used for an interim student food services location, at Canyon HS Science Center, in the amount of \$125,487 for a two (2) year lease term. An additional amount of \$18,823 (15%) is being added as contingency for a total cost of \$144,310, pursuant to the contract awarded by the Savanna School District.

## **Program Budget Update**

The January 2019 Monthly Report was issued. The budgets are based upon the 95% Construction
Documents Cost Estimates completed by the Construction Managers (updated from the
Construction Cost Estimates based upon the Construction Document Designs).

- On 1/23/19, held the next planning meeting with the design team and school staff for El Modena HS.
- Awaiting proposal from gkkworks / Cannon Design Architect on the formulation of a "Basis of Design" package for use in the District meetings to finalize the Phase II design for Canyon High School.

## **Procure Electrical System Equipment**

 As of 2/28/19, prepare a board item to recommend award of ACCO Engineered Systems to provide the Owner Furnished Contractor Installed (OFCI) Electrical System Equipment at Canyon HS Science Center, using CMAS Agreement, in the amount of \$159,985.61, with an estimated savings of; \$26,398 (using 16.5% GC markup cost).

## **Contractor Pre-Qualification**

- Prequalification activity for El Modena HS Science Center pursuant to the current bid;
  - 9 Prime Contractors are eligible to bid S1819-005 EMHS Sci Center attended mandatory
    job walk and prequalified with audited financials and sufficient single bonding capacity.
- As of 11/21/18, current contractor prequalification includes:





- 24 Prime/GC's 17 large Prime Contractors are included in this category and able to financially qualify and perform at the level required to bid the large projects at the high schools.
- There are currently 124 Mechanical / Electrical / Plumbing contractors' (there were 36 MEP's added during the Orange HS Science Center outreach for S1819-001).
- To date, two marketing efforts for Measure S Program projects included invitations to 382 contractors and 5 plan rooms. Refer to the reoccurring marketing of projects;
- Each project advertised for bidding will include extensive marketing efforts to maintain a large pool of qualified contractors able to bid Measure S Program projects.
- Projects are posted to American Reprographics Company (ARC) public plan room, which a large well-known plan room and heavily utilized by school districts for posting of bids.
- Project general information and a link to ARC is also posted on the District's website, under the Measure S Program.
- Prospective contractors continue to submit pre-qualification applications, which continue to be reviewed by the District and the Program Manager on a rolling basis.

## **Project Achievements**

- January 31, 2019, Canyon HS STEM Building received DSA approval of plans (DSA Application #04-117300).
- January 17, 2019, the Board approved, Orange HS Increment # 01; Change Order # 4 in the amount of: \$161,049.42. This change order is comprised of the following proposed change order's (PCO): 17, 18, 20, 21, 24, 26, and 33, reflecting; 8.31% of the 10% (\$596,542) change order contingency.
- January 17, 2019, the Board approved, Orange HS Increment # 01; Change Order # 3 in the amount of: \$33,874.56. This change order is comprised of the following proposed change order's (PCO): 8, 9, and 12.
- January 17, 2019, the Board approved, Orange HS Increment # 01; Change Order # 2 in the amount of: \$42,086.09. This change order is comprised of the following proposed change order's (PCO): 13, 14, 15, and 16.
- January 7, 2019, a Notice to Proceed was to issued Pinner Construction Co. for Orange HS Science center (Increment # 2), reflecting a 02/18/19 start date.
- January 7, 2019, the Girls (and Boys) restroom, Orange HS Increment # 1, building 500, was completed and turned over for School use.





- December 28, 2018 A Notice to Proceed was to issued Angeles Contractor for the Interim Housing and Science Center project, reflecting a 01/07/19 start date.
- December 13, 2018, the Board approved the Construction Management Master Agreement Amendment # 2 for Balfour Beatty in order to clarify Master Agreement language in terms of the onsite construction trailer rental for the Balfour Beatty staff and the District Inspector of Record offices, which allows for the trailer rental to be removed as a contract deliverable (Exhibit E, Item 114) and submitted as a reimbursable cost under the current contract language previously approved in Amendment #1, there is no fiscal impact.
- December 13, 2018, the Board approved the Construction Management Master Agreement Amendment # 2 for Gafcon. The proposed amendment transfers the responsibility to provide offices for the construction management staff and Inspector of Record to the awarded contractor for the science center project and will be included in the hard cost construction bid, there is no fiscal impact.
- December 13, 2018, the Board approved the Construction Management Master Agreement
   Amendment # 2 for Cordoba. The proposed amendment transfers the responsibility to provide
   offices for the construction management staff and Inspector of Record to the awarded
   contractor for the science center project and will be included in the hard cost construction bid,
   there is no fiscal impact.
- December 13, 2018, the Board approved Pinner Construction for the Orange HS Science Center project (Increment # 2) project, Bid No. S1819-003 Orange High School Science Center at \$26,109,000. This bid is within the estimated budget for this project.
- December 13, 2018, the Board approved Angeles Contractor as the responsive responsible bid for the Villa Park HS – Interim Housing & Science Center project, Bid No. S1819-002 Villa Park High School Interim Housing - Science Center, at \$23,997,000. This bid is within the estimated budget for this project.
- December 13, 2018, the Board approved contract amendment # 1 for P2S to conduct commissioning for the following systems in the Satellite Kitchen at Orange HS Increment # ¹; Split System Indoor Fan Coil Unit (x2); ². Split System Outdoor Heat Pump (x2); ³. Exhaust Fan (x1), in the amount of \$4,755.
- On December 13, 2018, the Board approved contract amendment # 3 for Harley Ellis Devereaux (HED) to provide architectural and engineering services for Measure S projects at El Modena High School. To provide conceptual "basis of design" Phase 2 drawings / renderings for a fee of \$28,560. An additional amount of \$2,000 is being added to cover reimbursable costs and contingency for a total authorization of \$30,560.





- On December 13, 2018, the Board approved contract amendment # 3 for LPA, Inc. to provide architectural and engineering services for Measure S projects at Villa Park High School. To provide conceptual "basis of design" Phase 2 drawings/renderings for a fee of \$76,000. An additional amount of \$1,000 is being added to cover reimbursable costs and contingency for a total authorization of \$77,000.
- On December 13, 2018, the Board approved contract amendment # 3 for Lionakis to provide bidding services for the re-bid of Orange HS Science Center (\$1819-003). Services include; architectural, interior design, structural engineering, electrical / low voltage, engineering, mechanical engineering, landscape architect. Assumes the same DSA approved plans and specifications used in the original bid package, along with approved addenda, will be used for re-bidding the project, in the amount of \$18,700.

 Recommend award of Bid No. S1819-005 El Modena High School Science Center to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, Angeles Contractor, in the amount of \$25,818,000, whose bid is also within the estimated budget for this project. Award a moving services contract to Beltmann Relocation Group for Villa Park HS Interim Housing & Science Center, to facilitate the temporary relocation of the Building 300 classrooms to nine (9) interim housing modular classrooms on April 2, 2019. The interim housing units have been installed on the south side of campus. The District recently conducted an informal bidding process and received three (3) proposals for moving services at Villa Park High School.

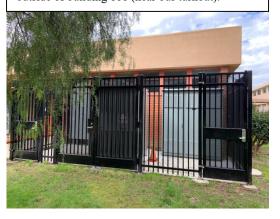

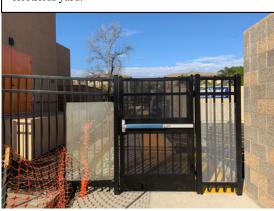

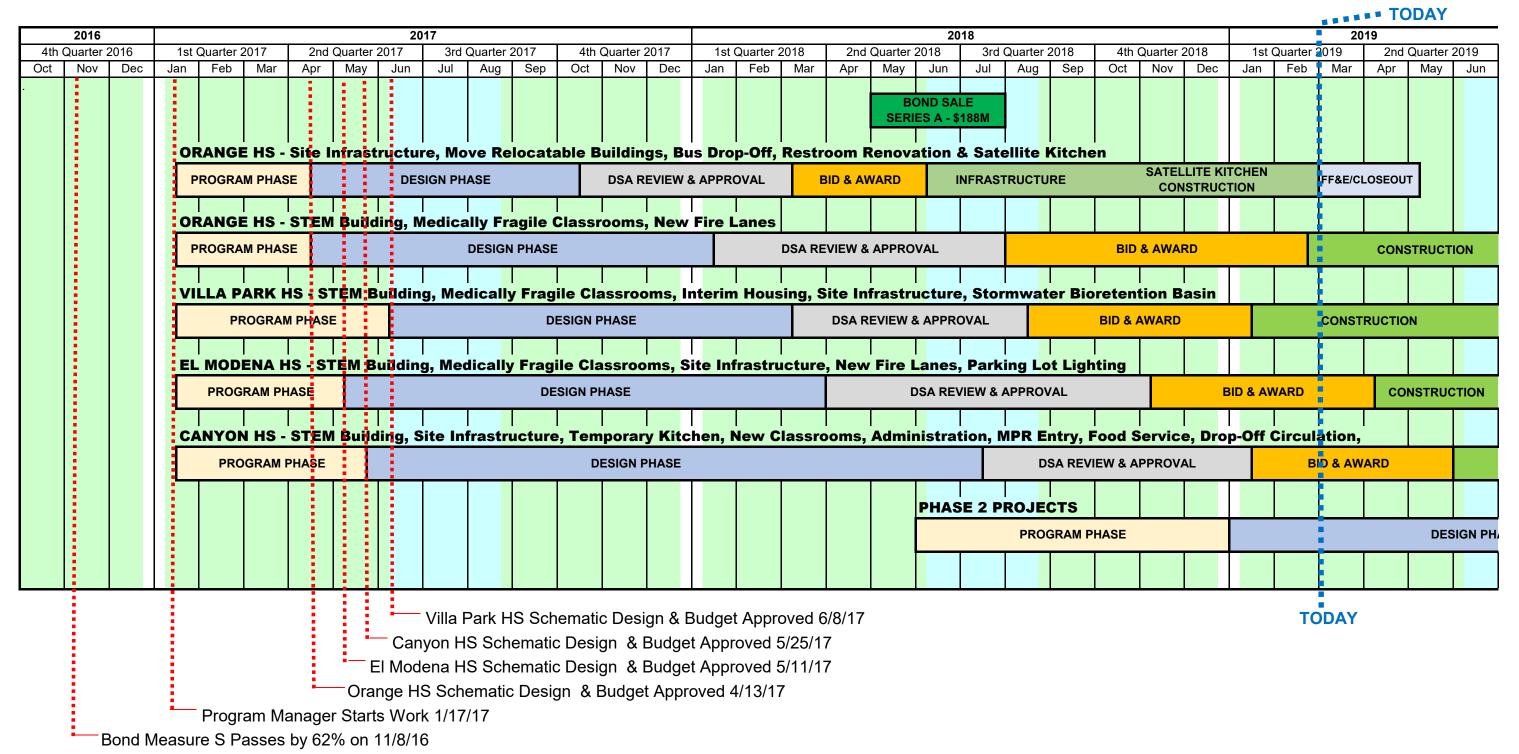

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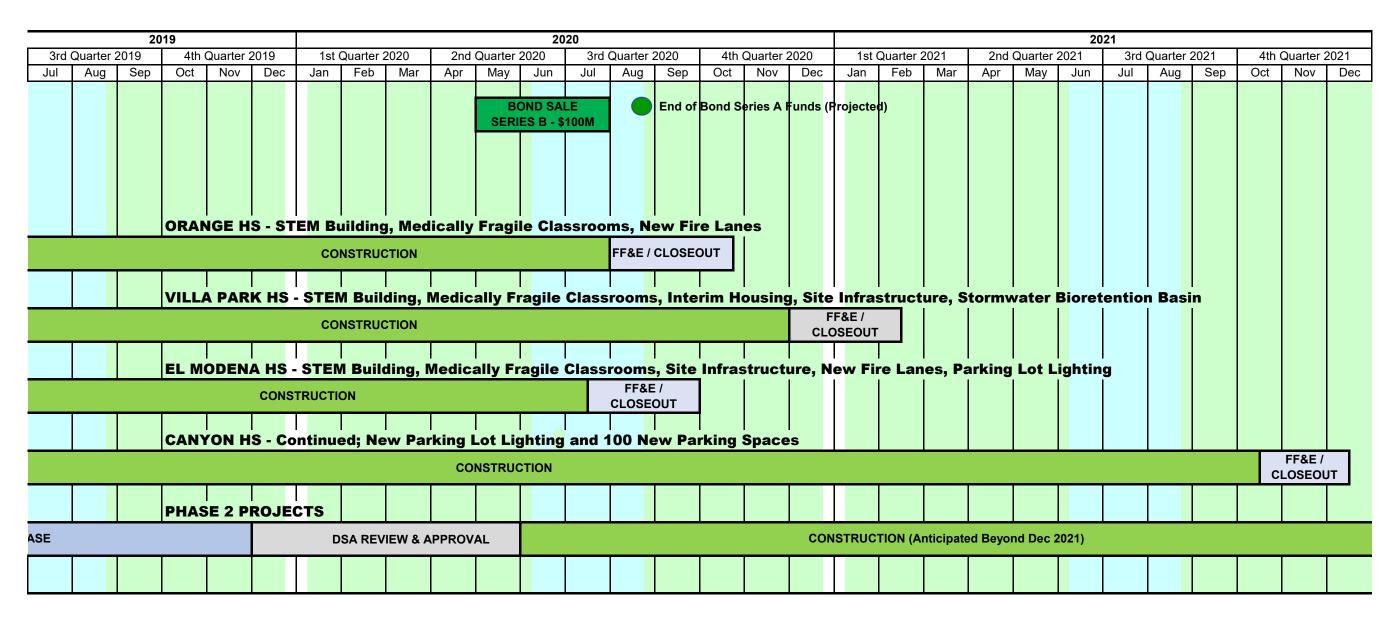
