AFTERNOON CARE LEADER (\$12-15/hr), Mon–Fri 3-6 PM

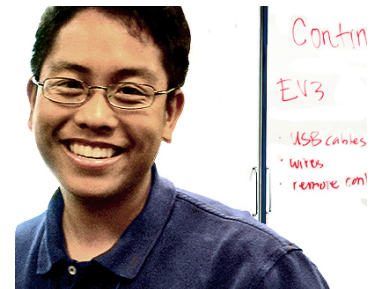
