- The tour began with an opening meeting on Sunday November 11 in Riga then visited schools in Riga, Stockholm, Lund, Malmo, Copenhagen, and Stavanger.
- This tour included 26 higher education institutions from Canada, Europe, and the United States that visited nine schools and saw 1360 students. It also included briefings on the Swedish loan program (CSN) and the Norwegian Educational System.
