Topics

Student Behavioral Concerns

- No data to share
- Students serving on the Youth Commission presented to Clearfield City. Per their poll, students at Clearfield High School are most concerned about mental health, not student behavior
- The SHARP survey was recently administered; however, data is not available at this time.
- Students serving on HOPE Squad are the eyes and ears of the school. Their role is to refer those they know are struggling emotionally and mentally.

Elections

- There are four open positions.
- Voting will be from May 6 to May 10 through the My.DSD system.
- Newly elected members will be invited to our final community council meeting this school year.

Trust Land Expenditures Revisited

- Revision: The \$10,000 set aside for refreshing printers will be moved, leaving \$26,000 for teacher grants.
- Mr. Keime will send out land trust application form this Friday, April 19, 2019.
- Limits: \$1,500 per teacher; \$8,000 per department
- Must be tied to SIP goals and student learning

TSSP Funding

- Available funds: \$190,000
- Student learning is tied to people, technology that individualize personal learning, and professional development.
- Stipends for AP, IB, and CE teachers will be considered.
- New offerings at Clearfield High School and encouraging students to enroll in IVC classes away from our school.
- Currently working on an agreement with Weber State University so students can earn a certificate of completion
