## STUDENT WALKERS

Families may give permission for students to walk to school and home after school. To ensure the safety of your children, the following practices are in effect:

- Written permission must be provided to the school. If changes occur, this must also be documented in writing.
- A NHC crossing guard works on Castle Hayne Road each day to assist children in crossing the street in the morning and in the afternoon.

### *Morning*

- Wrightsboro staff is on duty beginning at 7:30 a.m. each morning. Students are directed to their classrooms or to breakfast in the cafeteria.

### *After School*

- All students who walk home from school meet in a room in the main building at dismissal.
- Wrightsboro staff members walk children to the crossing guard who then assists them in crossing the street.
- Children in grades K-2, must be escorted by an adult or a child in grades 3-5.
- Family members may wait across the street to receive students. Please make certain to list the names of the family members authorized to receive your child.
- If older students are to walk younger students home, please list the names of the students.
- If older students are to walk younger students home, please consider a back-up plan in the event the student is absent from school.
- Parents who walk to school to meet their children are asked to wait across the street with the crossing guard or outside the building on the sidewalk if they are not crossing the street. Students will not be dismissed until 2:30.
