Many parents are desperately seeking help with issues around anxiety, behaviours and even some scary levels of aggression. At Lynch Hill we are using all the resources available to us and aim to support as many children as we can, however, with budget restrictions this is becoming more difficult to do.

Mrs Clarke has been discussing our (and your) concerns with local professionals and has been able to arrange for many of them to offer some of their invaluable time and experience to attend some sessions open to you as parents.

We are so pleased to be able to offer these special Parent Support Groups held here at school for our parents. These groups will include professionals such as Dr Helen Cox, Rachel Jolly, Mandy Parsons, Slough social workers, Speech and language therapists.

The groups will cover themes to support parenting, attachment, behaviour management and special needs. We have booked in 6 sessions over the next few weeks.
