

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

Advanced Placement Courses are available to all MISD students, 9th through 12th grades. AP course content is rigorous and governed by the the College Board. AP courses have the reputation of being among the best preparation for future college/ university study. AP teachers are highly qualified in their teaching area and their curriculum must be approved and meet College Board criteria. AP students can earn college credits via performance on AP exams taken in May of each year.

MISD subsidizes AP testing fees for students enrolled in AP classes. For more information about the AP

TCC Dual Credit Courses



Dual credit courses are offered in MISD through a partnership with Tarrant County College and enable students to earn credits that are likely transferrable to most Texas public colleges. These community college level courses are offered on all high school campuses and are available to students who take and pass the TSI assessment. Fees for these courses are minimal, and MISD provides necessary textbooks.



iStart - Accelerated Dual Credit

iStart is a specialized partnership between MISD and TCC and allows students to begin dual credit classes the summer before their junior year. Students in this program are required to complete a minimum of 30 dual credit hours prior to graduation from high school. iStart students have the opportunity to take more dual credit courses at a

reduced price for up to 48 hours. Participation in this program is by application and requires that students take and pass the TSI assessment. For more information about iStart:

TCC TREC Program

The TCC TREC Program is a partnership between MISD and the TCC Trinity River East Campus and provides Frontier High School health science students an opportunity to earn up to 54 dual credit



college hours and a certification. Participation in this program is by application prior to the junior year and requires that students take and pass the TSI assessment. UTA Bound for Success Program

The Bound for Success partnership awards MISD juniors at all high schools in the top 25% of their class pre-admission to UT Arlington, contingent upon their completion of a college preparatory diploma. The UT Arlington-Mansfield ISD partnership also allows qualifying students to choose dual credit courses through the College of Engineering and the MISD's "Project Lead the Way" Science, Technology, Engineering and Math sequence. Or, qualifying MISD students may select a dual credit Criminology Criminal Justice program aligned with the district's Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security program.
