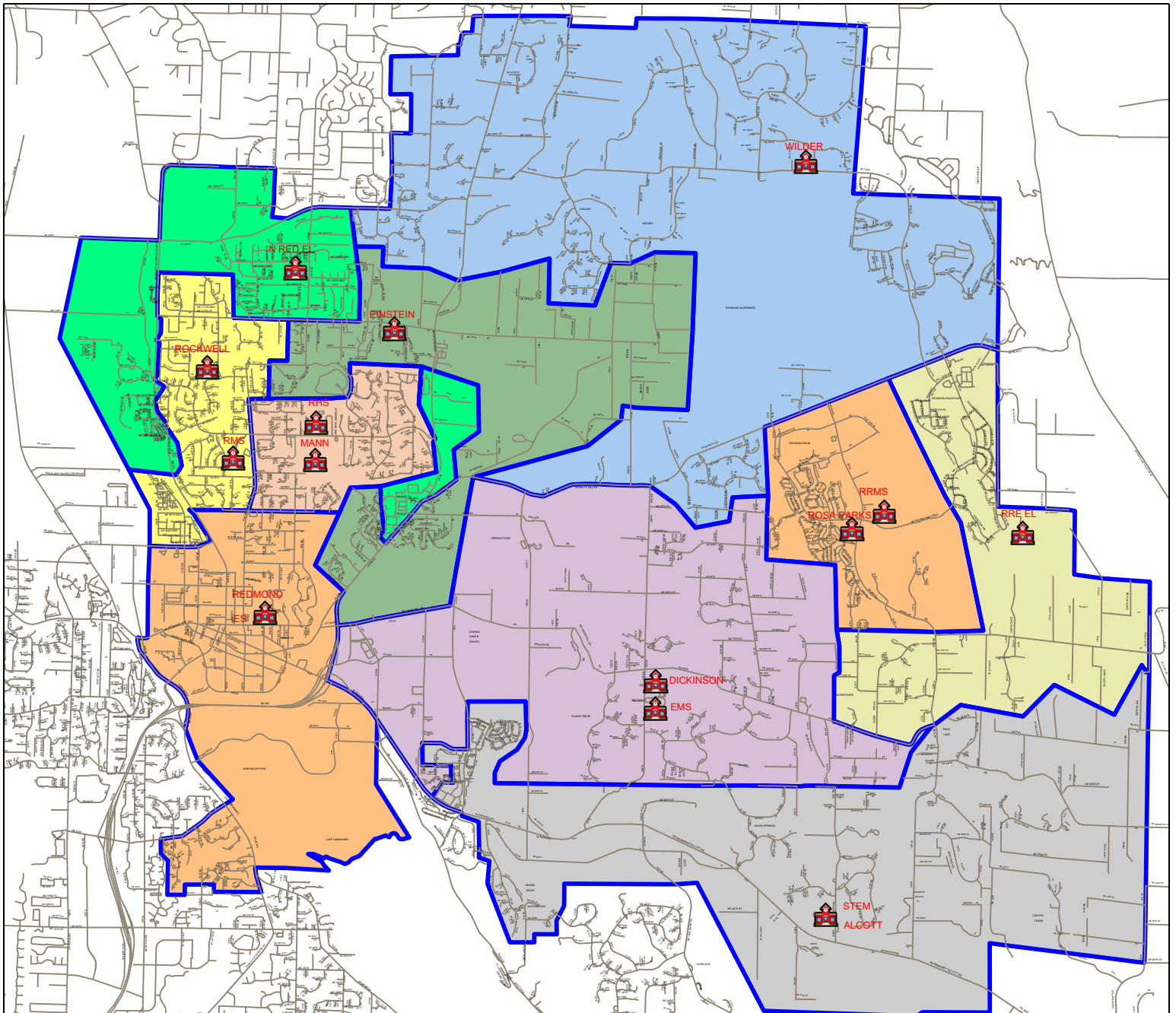

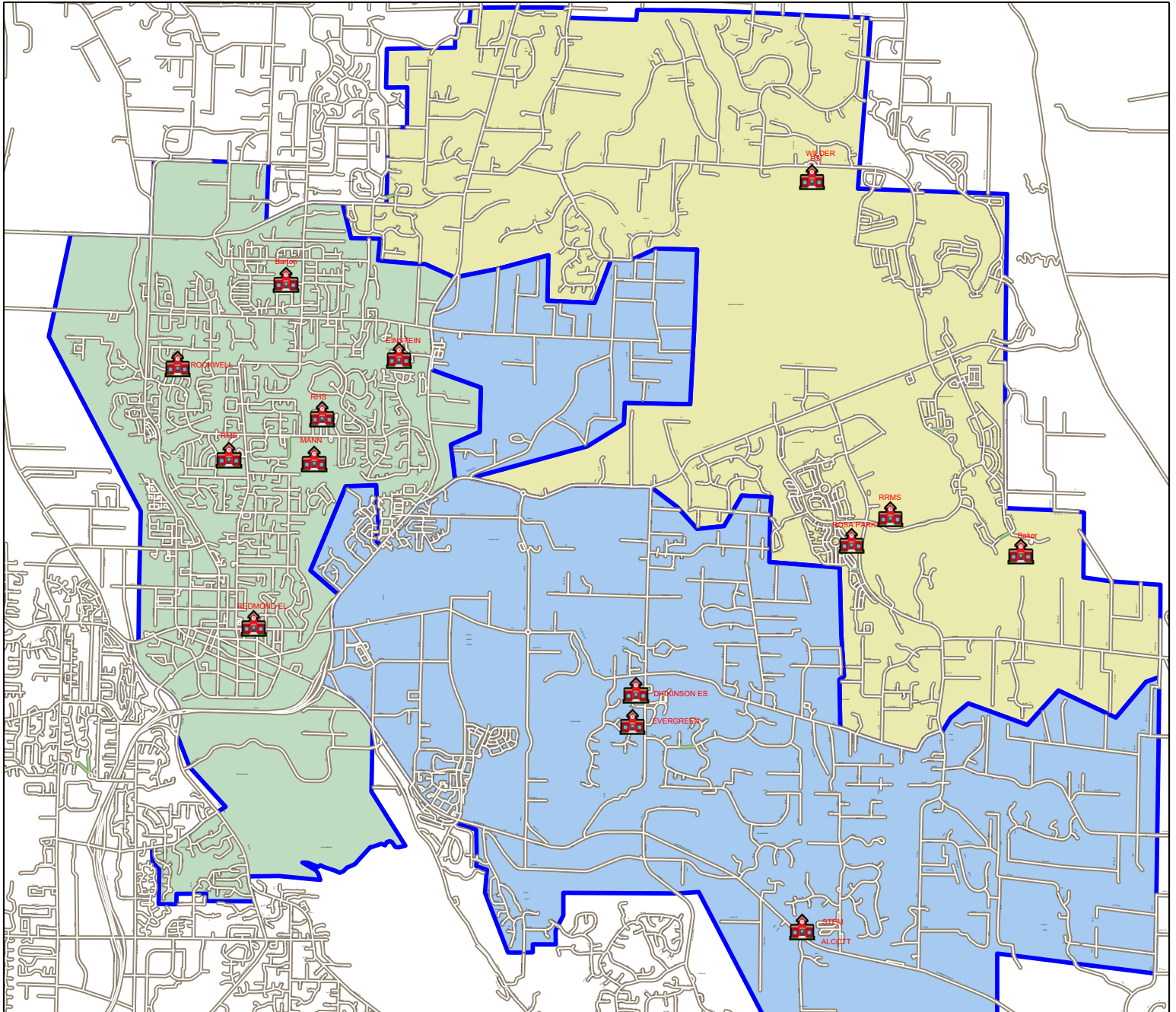

Current Capacity Summary and Enrollment Projections

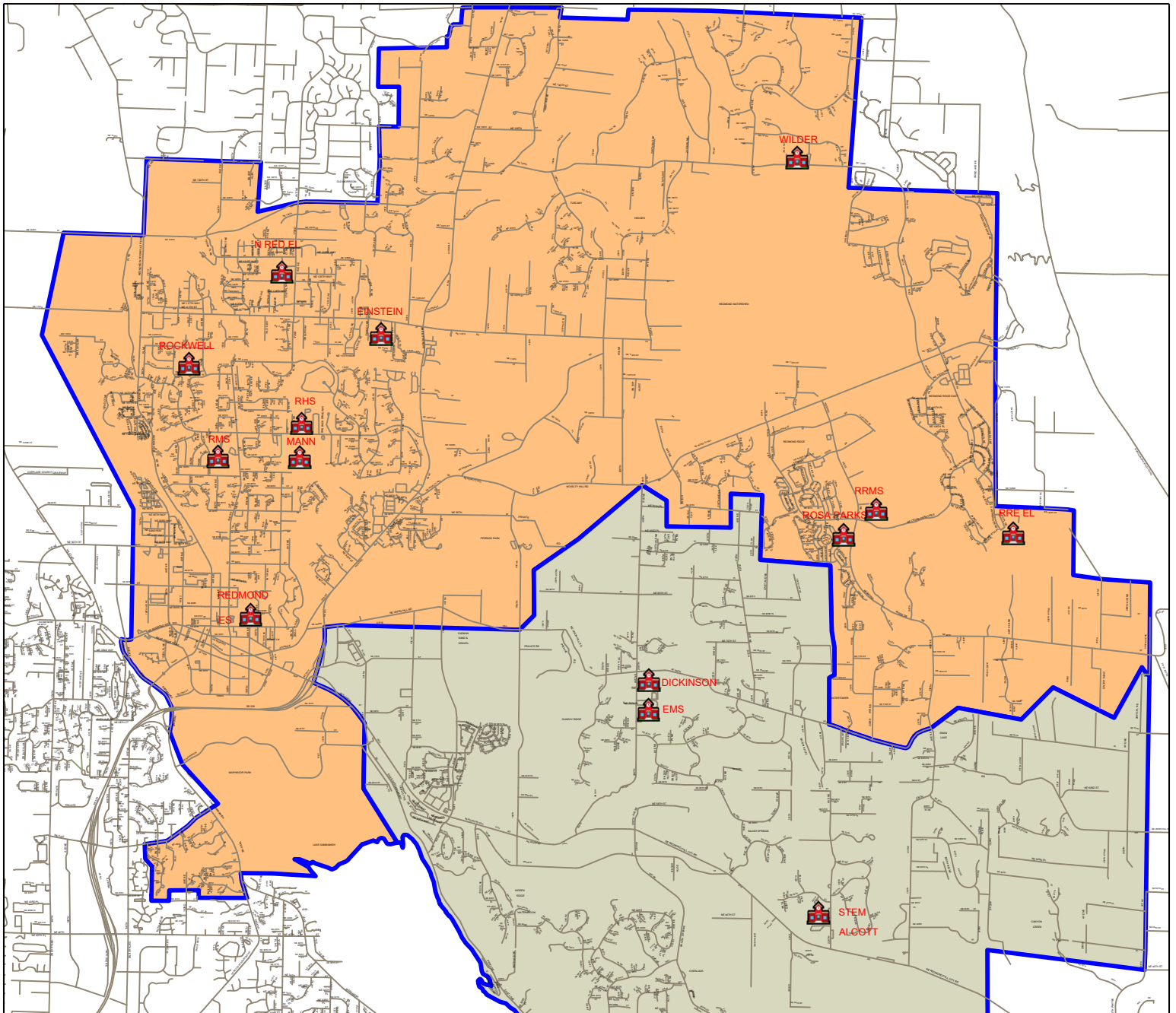
The chart below shows enrollment for High Schools in the Redmond and Eastlake Learning Communities. Current projections show Eastlake High School growing to 2,400 students. A Choice Secondary School will be on the 2018 bond and will be located in the Redmond/Eastlake area to relieve the overcrowding at these schools. Revised scenario A & B move approximately 50 future high school students from Eastlake to Redmond High School.

Projected enrollment is determined by taking current students from the elementary schools and current middle school students, moving them ahead a grade in future years and adding in students from known future developments and expected growth.
