

COURSE WORK

One semester of course work equals 5 credits, 10 credits equaling 1 year of course work. Taking seven courses each semester for four years and completing community service allows the student to complete 290 credits. The 270 credits listed under **Graduation Requirements** are the minimum to graduate. Additional course work in Modern & Classical Languages, Mathematics and Science is recommended by the UC and California State University systems.
