It includes all the dignity, pomp and ceremony of a traditional graduation ceremony. <u>Your participation in these</u> <u>commencement exercises is not mandatory</u> for you to receive your Davis High School Diploma. **Therefore,** *should you choose to participate in the Davis High School Graduation Exercises, there are a few requirements and stipulations that we insist on. They are:*

- All participants will have fulfilled the qualifying academic and citizenship requirements in order to "walk" (participate in the commencement exercises).
- *Graduates must wear a pressed cap and gown.*
- Senior men must wear a dress shirt and tie, long slacks, and dress shoes
- Senior women must be in best dress, with dress shoes (no flip-flops)
- High Honor and Honor cords are the **ONLY** additional accessories that are allowed to be worn with the traditional gown. Additional decoration will be removed before entrance.
- *Please* no leis, corsages, medals, ethnic traditional dress, or uniforms.
- Graduates will be expected to be courteous and dignified during the processional, during the conferring of diplomas, and during the recessional.
- We expect that your parents, family members, and friends who may wish to attend will be respectful of all of the graduates and **refrain from using noise-makers, applause, or cheering which would prohibit all of the graduates' names from being easily heard by the audience.** Violators will be "ushered" out of the ceremonies.
- Each graduate will receive his or her ticket along with their cap and gown.
- Plan to take photos **before** the graduation ceremony. After the commencement exercises you will return your RENTED gown to Jostens before receiving your diploma.
