

New Hutchinson School Site Plan

Arrival/Dismissal

- Arrival Enter through either 3rd/Gym, 3rd/Lincoln, or Main entrance
- Doors open at 8:10 am
- Students line up by grade in gym
- Doors close at 8:25am enter through greeter entrance after 8:25am
- Dismissal out 3rd Ave. doors
- No traffic permitted on 3rd Ave. between 7:45 8:30am and 2:45 - 3:30pm except residents.

Recess/Lunch

- 30 minute lunch/30 minute recess
- Cross 3rd Ave. as a group and walk to Julianne's Playground
- Playground closed to the public when in use by the school
- Additional safety precautions (golf cart, walkie talkies, first-aid kits, safety vests, etc.)
- Porta-potty on site
- Parent drop off at school only not the playground

Safety Drills

- Collaboration with local Police and Fire Departments
- Fire and Evacuation drill routes adjusted
- Building staff trained on new routes
- Safety plan coordinated with construction manager and workers
- Practice drills before June
- Emergency Services access to building through construction site

Parking/Traffic Control

- Staff parking south of Lincoln Ave.
- Construction parking west of school property and on construction site
- Lincoln Ave. construction entrance and exit only
- 3rd Ave. closed to traffic during arrival and dismissal
- Crossing guards located at Lincoln & 3rd and 5th & 3rd
- Parent drop-off recommended south of Lincoln near funeral home, north of Lincoln on 4th Ave.
- Drop and go on passenger side only at 5th and 3rd

June 24-26 Plans

- June 24th, 25th, 26th are 12pm release days for elementary students
- All end of year activities will happen as planned (ex. 1st Grade Show)
- Determining alternate locations to "beat the heat" and possible noise:
 - Use of Franklin Field (Possible collaboration w/ Pelham Together)
 - PMHS Auditorium
 - PMHS/PMS Cafeteria
 - Pelham Picture House

Noise/Air/Site Safety

- Coordinated safety plan with construction team (badges, fingerprinted, access plans, etc.)
- Sound regulations as per NYSED monitored by Construction Management
- Dust reduction protocols in place per site work contract specifications
- Rodent control plan in place per sitework contract specifications
- Construction fencing to keep "attractive nuisance" temptation to a minimum
- Explosives not stored on site overnight
