### **Health is offered in-seat (meet Monday – Thursday)**

*We recommend that students complete health over the summer as it is a graduation requirement.*

- Students will choose either an 8AM or 10AM 2 hour session (students must attend)
  - Excessive absences or absences without instructor approval will result in student being dropped from the course
- Students will complete the course in 2 weeks
- The Health course is online with teacher support– students should work on their own to complete the course more quickly
- Instructors will work with students who are in sports camps

*Students enrolled in the medical pathway will meet the health requirements and do not need to take the Health class.*

*Students who do not meet Health class requirements will be enrolled in online health during one quarter of the school year*
