*Megan Snow report--Endeavor hired an extra person. It is a mom with no special training and no teaching certificate. She taught herself by working hard. We could have a volunteer do this if they were willing

We need to bring programs into the school

*Brad Petersen report

Utah Robotics- company based out of Provo—they bring supplies—It appears to be \$150 for 12-1 hour classes This is worth calling to find out. Will they come to Davis County?
Brad will call and find out more

*Brad Petersen discussed Lego-Mindstorm Competition. There is a league hosted by Centerville Elementary this year for competitions. Includes engineering and coding
Split into 1-2 grades, 3-4 grades and 5-6 grades
Mindstorms are more 4-6 grades
We Dos have a kit for 1-2 graders, maybe 2-4 graders (We Do 2.0)
Would need 30 minutes 2-3 Times a week to make this worthwhile. Need maybe 45 minutes.
Use Rolling cart. Maybe could train SEM teacher to travel and do this in classrooms.
Program, robotics, engineering
Core set about \$159 each
Whole program about \$800
2-3 kids at a time
need to bring in another person or two to help
Maybe we could sign up to host competitions.
Ready Go Classroom Pack starts at about \$750.00. The picture looks like about 12 kits

*Christina Brimhall doing STEM club after school, starts in December

*After school drama club starting—think ANNIE is the play. Ms. Sifre, Mrs. Packer and one other. New mic sets were ordered

*We need a push on keyboarding- home row-school got some kind of program for this

*We need to be vigilant about how Science and Spanish are taught. Is there a disconnect?
There are interim science tests they can take
They need to have practice on the testing tool, know how to manipulate
No longer spitting out facts--math oriented, process oriented, figure it out and write about it

*JSSC would like a STEAM night in March (not sure how weather would be? Plans for March night?) Arts, added to STEM is STEAM
--maybe incorporate 5K Microbe-offer a night
PTA and community did this in the past, want to include teachers, curriculum
Last year Miss Farmington had a science night with rocket launch, chem lab, animals, etc.

March- School wants to do a Science Night, maybe Utah Robotics? Brad will check this out

Could we Hire teacher to come in-extra pay with/from Microbe 5K?

*Who can help us write grants? There was one made available last week through Tyson Grover, due in early December. STEM program, \$10,000
Does anyone know a good grant writer? Forward any names on to Mrs. Magalei. She will check with Kari Stewart by email
Someone could be willing to help grant writer-from beginning of the year. Someone signed up they would be willing to help grant write. Does anyone remember who this person is?
Can we fund a new or extra person for Science teaching with trustlands \$? Not now
We need more technology. At least one more rolling lab needed. We currently have 2. We need more access for the kids. Want Lenovos \$400+ each, we would want a rolling cart with charging \$2300+?

*Mrs. Magalei's Title I colleagues (many of whom responded) have many resources. Many have the MESA program. This is geared more toward girls to get them into science.

*Did any teachers respond to the email from Mrs. Magalei about needs or wants for science? She can only think of one. Couldn't find it at that moment. Mrs. Haycock said she responded wanting a rain gauge, anemometer, planet model, sun, moon, earth rotation
DESK standards- teachers teach to this, most often have classroom supplies
How can we supplement what they teach in class?
Right now they are very focused on Math and LA. Science is later in the year. They may not really know what they need right now.
Include Meridee's email in the minutes. (I don't have a copy of this to include)

*Keri Stewart email- garden--School gardening club--plant vegetables, plant in spring, pumpkins, volunteers for summer, harvest in fall

*We could maybe hire a prep person, put out on jobs, doesn't require a certified teacher, maybe not til next year, don't have money currently, maybe if we got a grant
Surprising what you find-list as job-help screen applicants
Are there others in the community who would volunteer hours to do this? Keep eyes and ears open, maybe advertise it
TA-could come help with teachers possibly

*May do Microbe 5K through running club-do in the spring?

*\$11,500 we discussed last time from trust lands \$ set aside for this year for technology
Mrs. Magalei bought a screen. She will revisit this amount to see what we have left to get Mindstorms, We Dots and extenders.
Cyber Monday may have less expensive Mindstorms
Will purchase some We Dots with some of the left over money. A teacher or parent could volunteer to help
Could do a lego club?
Could we have clubs sponsored by businesses? YES, why not
